## (The Shoe Box Ministry)

Get Ready and Mark Your Calendar! From November 13 through November 20, Trinity Episcopal Church, Wetumpka, has been chosen to be the collection center for this years annual **Operation Christmas Child Shoebox Ministry**. We have the perfect location and the perfect people for this worthwhile and important job. Our parish has proven that we really do "Trust in the Lord and Do Good."

Churches from around our area will bring filled shoeboxes to Trinity for delivery to Montgomery which will, in turn, be forwarded for worldwide distribution. During these eight days, we expect 1,100 to 1,500 boxes to be delivered. Two to three hours each day five to seven volunteers will be needed to receive, count, catalog, and accumulate the boxes. We ask that you strongly consider volunteering for this worthwhile project. In addition to volunteers, Trinity will need trailers, pickups, or vans to transport the shoeboxes to Montgomery. Covered trailers would be excellent as we would be able to pack and store the boxes at the same time.
