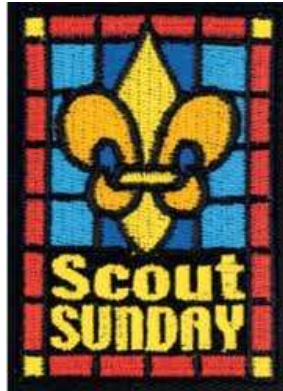

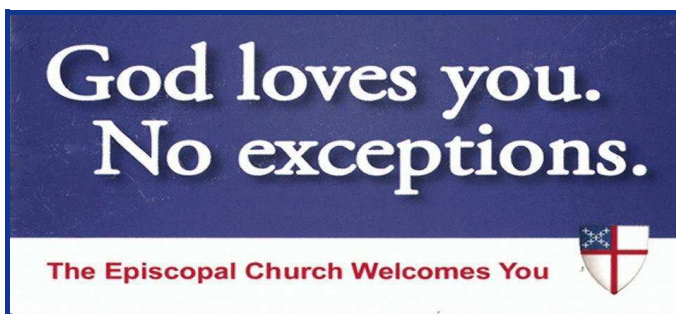

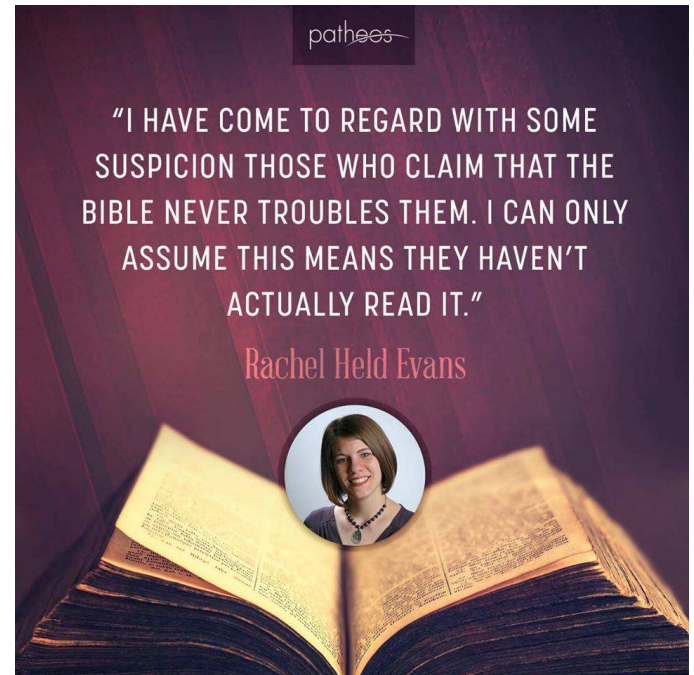
The pack will host Meet & Greet, so be sure to come by and meet the scouts and their parents.

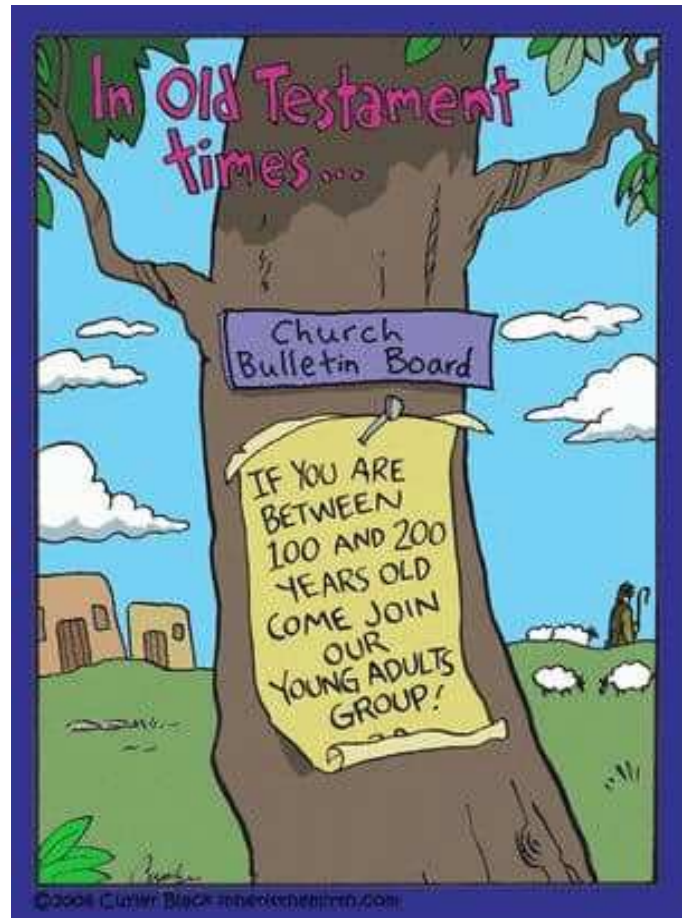

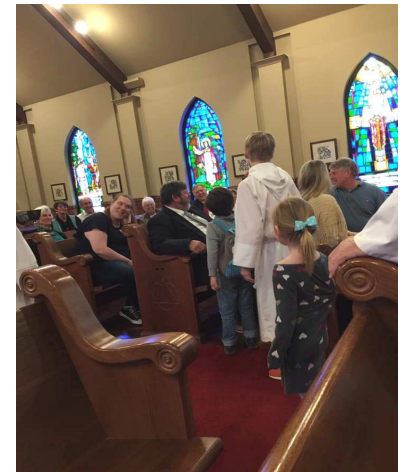
