Kathy Atchison reviewed our Newcomer plan, and on our behalf, thanked Barbara Davis for her work baking and delivering homemade bread to all visitors as well as Warren Jones who sends a card to visitors.

Junior Warden Tom Hollon and his side-kick, Gary Wright were recognized and thanked for their hard work on the Trinity buildings and grounds. They are here every week to do whatever is necessary to keep the yard looking nice and the buildings in repair. Bob reminded the congregation that we need to thank Sandy Hallmark and Beverly Roberts who clean and vacuum the nave, sanctuary and choir every week so it looks good on Sunday.

Judie Hooks described the work of the Altar Guild and encouraged others to join the Guild in their weekly work of service and offering to God.

Bob reminded us that Beverly Roberts is one of the unsung heroes of Trinity, who, more than anyone knows, helps the parish in so many ways; all done in the background without fanfare, but without whom, the Parish and its activities would be greatly diminished. We owe her a great debt of gratitude.

## SCOUT SUNDAY

Join us this Sunday to welcome the scouts, parents and leaders of our sponsored Cub Scout Pack, Pack 50, as we celebrate Scout Sunday.

The Scouts and their leaders will process with us, sit together, leaders and scouts will participate in the service. In addition, Rutledge Rogers and another scout will receive the "God and Family" award, and there will also be a special presentation.

Trinity Parishioners are and have been heavily involved with Pack 50. Tyler and Philip Baughman "crossed over" from Pack 50 to Boy Scouts last year; Walter Lynch, Rutledge and Gaines Rogers, are members of the pack now; Rhonda Baughman, Matt Rogers and Walt Lynch are all adult leaders.

Pack 50 consists of 40-45 boys, kindergarten through 10 years old who are divided by age into groups called "Dens": Lions – entering cubs; Tigers – completed kindergarten or 7 years old; Wolves – completed first grade or 8 years old; Bears – completed second grade or 9 years old; Webelos – completed third grade or 10 years old; Arrow of Light – fifth-graders or 10 years old and have Webelos badge.

The God and Family Award is earned by completing a curriculum designed by Programs of Religious Activities with Youth (P.R.A.Y.), a national group which promotes denominational religious activities for all types of Youth Groups.

After the service, the Cub Pack will host Meet and Greet, so come in, meet and welcome them.

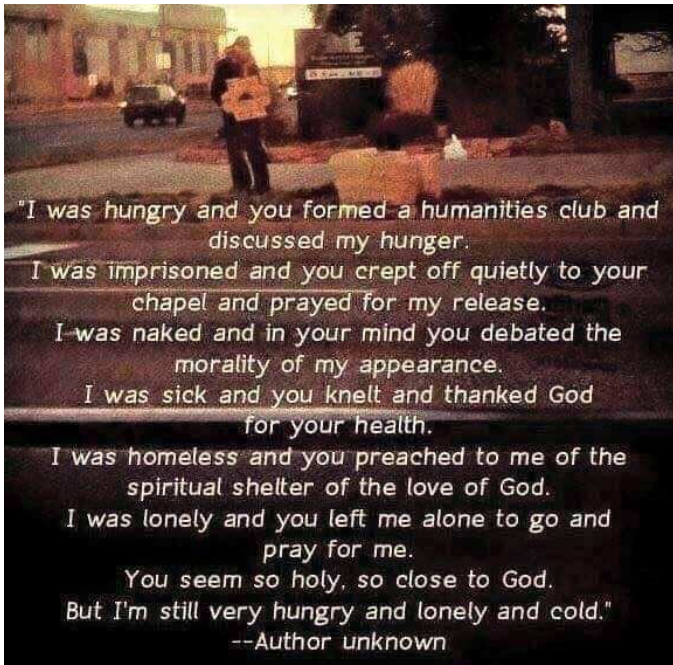
